

QUALIFICATION for the NRHA European Championships.

The NRHA Nordic Championship will have the same qualification terms.

1. To qualify to compete in the 2025 NRHA European Affiliate Championships, there will be no other requirements other than those listed below:

A rider must be a member of their home country NRHA European Affiliate in the year of 2024 and/or 2025 and must also have competed in at least one NRHA-approved European affiliate event (does not have to be in your home country) in the class they wish to compete at the Championships and receive a score (above zero). (It is only the rider, who needs qualification, not the rider/horse combination).

There will be two qualification periods. The first period will run January 1, 2024 through December 31. The second qualification period will run January 1, 2025 through May 15. If show results for events on or prior to May 15, 2025 are not received by NRHA by May 20, 2025 they will not count towards qualification.

The NRHA will provide a list of NRHA European members who have competed in NRHA European events in 2024 and 2025 in each class to the European Championship host no less than 30 days from the first day of the Championships. The list of those qualified will be posted on the NRHA European Championship website, and it will be the responsibility of each affiliate to monitor if their members have paid their affiliate membership dues.

If a rider competes in a class in 2024 and is no longer eligible for that class in 2025, he will be able to compete in that specific European Affiliate Championship class.

The membership requirement and qualification will be based strictly off the rider, and any horse may be used to compete in the classes.

2. Those entries qualified for the European Championships may enter only the European Championship classes in which they have qualified, even if they are no longer eligible for that class at the time of the European Championships. Category 1 eligibility will be used to determine rider eligibility. Riders qualified in Non Pro classes including Rookie I must have current NRHA Non Pro status to enter.
3. A rider may show only three (3) horses per class at the European Championships.
